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# INVITATION TO TENDER

issued pursuant to Section 28 paragraph (1) point b) and Section 53 paragraph (1) of Act No. 134/2016 Coll., on Public Procurement, as amended (hereinafter the "Act"),

for preparation of bids for below-threshold public contract for supplies

contracted within the simplified below-threshold procedure pursuant to Section 53 of the Act

## **Equipment for Post-Processing plastic 3D printed parts**





## 1 DEFINITION OF THE SUBJECT-MATTER OF THE PUBLIC CONTRACT

### 1.1 Classification of the subject matter of the Public Contract

Classification of this Public Contract corresponds to item:

- CPV code: 42900000-5 - Miscellaneous general and special-purpose machinery

**Type of public contract:** below-threshold public contract for supplies

**Type of procurement procedure:** simplified below-threshold procedure

### 1.2 Description of the subject matter of the Public Contract

The subject matter of this Public Contract is supply (acquisition) of equipment for post-processing plastic parts produced by 3D printing, specifically SLS, MJF, SAF, HSS and FDM/FFF technologies.

The Public Contract is divided into 2 parts:

- a) Part 1: **Equipment for spraying of plastic parts**
- b) Part 2: **Equipment for chemical smoothing of plastic parts**

The subject of Part 1 is the supply of equipment for spraying of plastic parts (two devices or one device for both processes described below). It must (i) remove excess powder from a plastic part and (ii) spray a plastic part to improve its surface quality/to smooth it (roughness reduction, matte finish).

The subject of Part 2 is the supply of equipment for smoothing the surface of plastic parts by evaporation of solvents.

All parts of equipment must be new, fully operational and complete. More detailed specification of the subject matter is provided in Article 4 below.

Bidders are entitled to submit a bid for one part or separately two bids for both parts of the Public Contract. Bidder can submit only one bid for each part of the Public Contract. If a bidder submits multiple bids within one part of the Public Contract, either alone or with other bidders, the Contracting Authority will reject all such bids.

### 1.3 Term

The subject of performance of the Public Contract must be properly delivered and handed over no later than **90 days from the date of conclusion of the relevant contract**, in the case of Part 1 and Part 2.

### 1.4 Place of Performance

Place of performance shall be the building of the "Brain 4 Industry" innovation centre in Za Radnicí street, Dolní Břežany, Czech Republic.

### 1.5 Estimated value

Estimated value of the Public Contract is **3.600.000,00 CZK excl. VAT**.

of which:

estimated value of Part 1: 1.600.000,00 CZK excl. VAT  
estimated value of Part 2: 2.000.000,00 CZK excl. VAT



The highest allowable bid price in terms of the Contracting Authority's financial resources is for **Part 1** the amount of **1.936.000,00 CZK including 21% VAT** and for **Part 2** the amount of **2.420.000,00 CZK including 21% VAT**. For that reason, a bid that would contain a bid price exceeding the specified limits for the relevant Part 1 or Part 2 will be excluded from the procurement procedure within that part.

## 2 CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS REGARDING THE DRAWING UP OF A BID

2.1 Bids shall be submitted in electronic form only, for each part of the Public Contract separately, using the Tender arena electronic tool. Any other delivery is not considered a proper submission of the bid. Bids in paper form are not permitted.

2.2 Bids for both parts of the Public Contract shall be submitted no later than on **JUNE 6, 2023, by 11:00 am.**

A bid delivered after this deadline shall not be considered to constitute a properly delivered bid.

2.3 To submit a bid, bidders will use the certified electronic tool Tender arena, available at <http://www.tenderarena.cz> (detailed instructions for using the tool are available at the indicated address, in the section for suppliers - <http://www.tenderarena.cz/dodavatel>, link "Help" to the address <https://sites.google.com/tendersystems.cz/help-tenderarena-contractor> in the header; at the address <http://www.tenderarena.cz> there are also available user support contacts).

2.4 To be able to submit a bid, the bidder must be registered as a contractor in the **Central Contractor Database**. The link to register is <https://cdd.fen.cz/#/>. Registration of the bidder takes up to 48 hours (on working days) after all required documents have been submitted (either by post or electronically). Registration in the system is not charged. Detailed information on the registration to the Central Contractor Database is available at <https://cdd.fen.cz/#/faq>.

2.5 The bidder must have a personal computer with a minimum of the following performance: CPU 1 GHz, 1024 MB memory, 20 GB hard drive. Personal computer must be connected to the Internet at a minimum connection speed of 2 Mbps (DOWNLOAD) / 512 Kbps (UPLOAD) and have an Internet browser installed (Mozilla Firefox version 73.0 and higher, Google Chrome version 80.0.3987.106 and higher, Opera version 66.0.3515.72 and higher, Microsoft Edge version 80.0.361.54 and higher).

2.6 The Contracting Authority points out that it bears no responsibility for any technical conditions on the bidder's side. The Contracting Authority recommends bidders to consider especially the speed of their Internet connection when submitting bids so that bids are submitted within the time limit for its submission. This means uploading all attachments of the bid and final submission of the bid to the Tender arena electronic tool.

2.7 Bids for both parts of the Public Contract must be prepared in Czech or English.

2.8 The bid must include **identification data of the bidder**, i.e. primarily: business name, registered office, identification number, legal form, persons authorized to act on behalf of / represent the bidder, contact details for correspondence.



- 2.9 The bid shall not exceed 200 MB; of which a maximum of 100 MB are documents proving qualifications and a maximum of 100 MB are other documents provided in bids. The bid must be processed through acceptable file formats, i.e. Microsoft Office (Word, Excel), Open Office, PDF, JPEG, GIF, or PNG. The bid values as specified in this TD will also be submitted to the procurement procedure by inserting them into the tender form, which will be displayed when submitting the bid. This is without prejudice to the obligation to submit other documents making up the bid.
- 2.10 Bids must be encrypted using a public key in the Tender arena electronic tool (the public key for encrypting the bid is published within the tender detail in the electronic tool). The **bid encryption** with the public key **is carried out automatically in the Tender arena** electronic tool before the bid submission is finalized. In the case of a bid being encrypted with other public keys (certificates), such a bid will be considered not delivered to the Contracting Authority in the proper manner and it will not be considered as submitted.
- 2.11 In the case several bidders jointly participate in the procurement procedure, they will also identify the person who shall be authorized to represent them in contact with the Contracting Authority during the procurement procedure.
- 2.12 The Contracting Authority does not specify the *award period* for this procurement procedure.
- 2.13 The bid must be submitted in the following structure:
- Cover Sheet** (please refer to Annex No. 1 hereto) separately for each part of the Public Contract for which the bidder submits a bid;
  - documents proving fulfilment of the qualification for the relevant part of the Public Contract** as set out in Article 3 hereof;
  - Draft Contract for the relevant part of the Public Contract**, including annexes, with the completed bid price, the offered warranty length and all other marked data (please refer to Annex No. 2a or 2b hereto);
  - Affidavit** of commitment to comply with the principles of socially responsible procurement and environmentally responsible procurement signed by a person authorized to act on behalf of the bidder (please refer to Annex No. 3 hereto).

### 3 QUALIFICATIONS

Bidders must demonstrate the fulfilment of **technical qualification** according to Section 79 (2) b) of the Act. Fulfilment of the technical qualification will be demonstrated by a bidder, who submits a list with at least 3 significant supplies provided over the past three years before the commencement of this procurement procedure, including price and date of provision and the identification of customer of the supply (supplies).

Being a significant supply shall be considered

- supply of any equipment matching the principle of function with the equipment whose supply is the subject of Part 1 of the Public Contract, with price of at least 500.000,00 CZK excl. VAT, in the case of Part 1 of the Public Contract; Contracting Authority requests provision of min. 2 such supplies;
- supply of any equipment matching the principle of function with the equipment whose supply is the subject of Part 2 of the Public Contract, with price of at least 1.200.000,00



CZK excl. VAT, in the case of Part 2 of the Public Contract; Contracting Authority requests provision of min. 2 such supplies.

If the price of a significant supply is stated in another currency, it will be converted at the exchange rate published by the European Central Bank on the day of the commencement of the procurement procedure.

#### **4 DETAILED DESCRIPTION AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION OF THE SUBJECT MATTER**

- 4.1 The subject matter of this Public Contract is fully specified in Annex No. 1 of the Draft Contracts which forms an integral part hereof as Annexes No. 2a and 2b.
- 4.2 The technical specifications listed in the tables in Annex No. 1 of the Draft Contracts are the minimum requirements that the equipment must meet. In the event that a bidder offers an equipment that does not meet the stated technical specifications, or does not contain all the described components, such a bidder will be excluded from the procurement procedure due to non-fulfilment of the procurement conditions. Technical specifications must be met also during installation of the equipment at the place of performance. The technical documentation submitted by the bidder shall form Annex No. 2 to the Draft Contract.
- 4.3 All offered equipment must comply with all requirements arising from technical or safety standards valid in the Czech Republic for these types of equipment. Performance required hereunder shall include handover of complete documentation to the equipment. The Contracting Authority requires that the entire subject matter and all its parts will be new, not re-used.

#### **5 STRUCTURE OF THE BID PRICE**

- 5.1 Bidders are obliged to specify the bid price for the relevant part of the Public Contract, including all required performance; the bid price is to be quoted in **CZK excl. VAT**.
- 5.2 The maximum bid price is **1.936.000,00 CZK including 21% VAT** for Part 1 and **2.420.000,00 CZK including 21% VAT** for Part 2 of the Public Contract. These maximum prices cannot be exceeded, and in the event that a bid is submitted with a bid price exceeding these limits, such a bid will be excluded from the procurement procedure.
- 5.3 The bid price must include the entire subject matter of the public contract and will represent a fixed, binding amount as the maximum amount and maximum admissible price, including all fees and other costs that may be associated with the performance provided hereunder, such as transportation to the place of performance, packaging, custom duties, assembly and installation costs, costs of insurance, etc.

#### **6 TERMS AND CONDITIONS, PAYMENT TERMS**

- 6.1 Terms and conditions incl. payment terms are specified in the attached binding Draft Contracts, which form an integral part hereof as Annexes No. 2a and 2b.
- 6.2 Bidders are obliged to accept without reservation or change the wording of the relevant Draft Contract. Bidders are authorized to fill in their identification data, the bid price and other clearly



marked information that are to be filled in. Bidders are not authorized to change or add to the Draft Contract in any manner, with exception of those parts which the Contracting Authority highlighted. Any breach of this condition may result in exclusion of the bidder from the procurement procedure.

## 7 EVALUATION CRITERIA

- 7.1 The equipment offered by a bidder must always meet the minimum technical specifications set out in the table in Annex No. 1 of the Draft Contract for the relevant part of the Public Contract (Annex No. 2a or 2b of the TD). Only bids meeting these minimum technical specifications will be evaluated.
- 7.2 The bids will be evaluated separately within each part of the Public Contract, based on their economic advantageousness. The Contracting Authority will evaluate the economic advantageousness of the bids within both parts of the Public Contract using the criteria below:

### The evaluation criteria are:

1. Total bid price excl. VAT in CZK - weight 76 %
2. Length of warranty period in months - weight 24 %

### 7.3 Evaluation method:

- 7.3.1 Within the evaluation criterion 1., the Contracting Authority will evaluate the total bid price in CZK excl. VAT, processed in accordance with Article 5 of the TD. The number of points awarded will be determined according to the formula below:

$$\text{Number of points} = \frac{\text{Lowest bid price within the evaluated bids}}{\text{Bid price of the evaluated bid}} \cdot 76$$

*Bidders shall state the bid price in CZK excl. VAT in the appropriate column in the Cover Sheet in Annex No. 1 of this TD and in the relevant provision (paragraph 5.1) of the relevant Draft Contract (Annex No. 2a or 2b of the TD). If a bidder states different values in the Cover Sheet and in the Draft Contract, the Contracting Authority will consider the value stated in the Draft Contract to be binding.*

- 7.3.2 Within the evaluation criterion 2., the Contracting Authority will evaluate the length of the warranty period. The minimum length of the warranty period is 12 months (i.e. a bid with a shorter warranty period will be rejected and excluded from the procurement procedure), the maximum evaluated length of the warranty period is 36 months (bids with a longer warranty period will be evaluated as if the offered length of the warranty period was 36 months).

The evaluated bid receives a point for each month by which the length of the warranty offered by the bidder exceeds the minimum required warranty period, which is set at 12 months.

*Bidders shall state the length of the warranty period in months in the appropriate column in the Cover Sheet in Annex No. 1 of this TD and in the relevant provision (paragraph 14.1) of the relevant Draft Contract (Annex No. 2a or 2b of the TD). If a bidder states different values in the Cover Sheet and in the Draft Contract, the Contracting Authority will consider the value stated in the Draft Contract to be binding.*



- 7.3.3 The number of points achieved within the individual criteria will be rounded to 2 decimal places. **The resulting order of the bidders within the individual parts of the Public Contract will be created by ranking the bids according to the total number of points achieved from the highest to the lowest. The bid with the highest number of points will always be evaluated as the most advantageous.**

## 8 ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS

- 8.1 The Contracting Authority does not admit variants of bids.
- 8.2 The Contracting Authority reserves the right to verify any information provided by bidders using third parties and bidders shall be obliged to provide the Contracting Authority with all necessary cooperation in this matter.
- 8.3 The Contracting Authority reserves the right to alter or amend the TD incl. its Annexes before the deadline for submission of bids, such a change would be announced in the way in which the TD was published. If the nature of the supplement or amendment of the TD requires it, the Contracting Authority simultaneously reasonably extends the deadline for submitting bids.
- 8.4 In line with Section 53 (5) of the Act, the Contracting Authority reserves the right that the notifications of the Contracting Authority associated with the course of the procurement procedure (notice of exclusion of a bidder and notice of the selection of the economic operator) shall be considered to be delivered at the point of time of their publication on the Contracting Authority Profile at <http://www.e-zakazky.cz/Profil-Zadavatele/74e987e1-b4a1-4571-b8b6-2cd93fe6f932>.
- 8.5 The selected bidder will be obliged to ensure compliance with all labour law regulations (remuneration, working hours, rest periods between shifts, paid overtime), as well as regulations concerning employment and occupational safety and health, for the entire duration of the contractual relationship established on the basis of this Public Contract, valid in the country of his registered office or place of business, to all persons, which will participate in the performance of the Public Contract (regardless of whether it is the Bidder himself or his subcontractors).
- 8.6 The selected bidder will be obliged to ensure compliance with environmental law in force in his country of residence or place of business, which meets the environmental policy objectives related to climate change, resource use and sustainable consumption and production, for the entire duration of the contractual relationship based on this Public Contract. The selected Bidder must therefore take all measures that can reasonably be required of him to protect the environment and reduce damage caused by pollution, noise and other activities, and must ensure that emissions, soil pollution and wastewater from his activities do not exceed the values laid down in the relevant legislation.

## 9 OPENING OF BIDS

Opening of bids shall take place immediately after the expiry of the bid submission date referred to in paragraph 2.2 of the TD. The opening of the bids will take place electronically, in accordance





with Section 109 of the Act.

## 10 COMMUNICATION DURING THE PROCUREMENT PROCEDURE

- 10.1 For communication during the procurement procedure, the Contracting Authority prefers the use of the electronic tool **Tender arena**.
- 10.2 Documents related to the procurement procedure will be sent by the Contracting Authority through the **Tender arena** electronic tool account of the Contracting Authority and the bidder or via e-mail with a guaranteed electronic signature.
- 10.3 in order to be able to communicate with the Contracting Authority via the electronic tool, bidders must be registered in the Central Contractor Database. The registration is carried out in accordance with paragraph 2.4 of this TD.
- 10.4 The Contracting Authority further emphasizes that in the case of communication carried out via the electronic tool, **the document is delivered at the moment of receipt of the data message** to the electronic mailbox of the recipient or recipients of the data message within the electronic tool.

## 11 CONCLUSION

- 11.1 Information and data provided herein (incl. all Annexes) define the binding requirements of the Contracting Authority with respect to the performance of the public contract. These requirements must be accepted by all bidders in full and without reservation, respecting these requirements in preparation of their bid. Non-acceptance of these requirements / conditions (incl. those specified in the respective Annexes) shall be deemed to constitute failure to comply with the tender conditions.
- 11.2 Should this TD or its Annexes refer to specific commercial trademarks / products or solutions, or other designations or visual presentations having relation to a specific supplier / manufacturer, it shall be understood as delineation of an anticipated characteristics and the bidder is entitled to propose other technically or qualitatively fully compliant solution.
