In accordance with Sections 98 and 99 of the Act, the Contracting Authority explains and supplements the Tender Documentation for the public contract "Equipment for highly sensitive measurements of magnetic properties".

1. The Contracting Authority corrects a numerical error in the technical specification in row No. 10 of the table "Tab. 1" in Annex No. 3 to the Tender Documentation. The new wording is as follows:

"Possibility to cancel residual magnetic flux to levels below the Earth's magnetic field, verification of outcome via fluxgate, controlled measurements in low magnetic field with precision of units of μT , in the field interval (minimum) $-1\text{mT} - 1\text{mT}$."

2. In order to clearly define the required temperature range for measuring DC and AC magnetic moment, which has so far been specified scattered within several parameters, a new row 4a with the following wording is inserted between rows 4 and 5 of the table "Tab. 1" in Annex No. 3 to the Tender Documentation:





“Possibility to measure DC and AC magnetic moment in temperature range from 350K down to at least 2K.”

In connection with the above, the Contracting Authority publishes the updated Annex No. 3 of the Tender Documentation (file entitled “Annex_3_Draft_Contract_UPDATED.docx”). Bidders are obliged to fill in and submit this version of the Draft Contract in their bids.

The Contracting Authority also extends the deadline for submission of bids in accordance with Section 99 of the Act.

The Contracting Authority therefore modifies the terms of reference, namely the first sentence of Clause 2.2 of the Tender Documentation which is now valid as follows:

2.2 Bids shall be submitted no later than on **May 22, 2024 by 11:00 am.**
